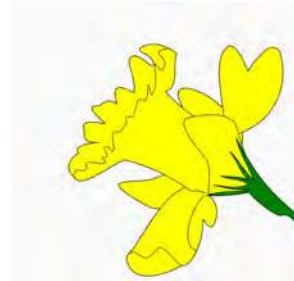

#### Chronic inflammation

\***Anti-inflammatory diet:** oily fish, olive oil, avocado, ginger walnuts, turmeric, cinnamon, dark leafy green vegetables, blueberries, broccoli, grapes, cauliflower, beetroot and carrot.

## A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY...

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 1894 the first families arrived and established themselves in what was to become Hautapu Street. Not all of the original settlers remained in Taihape, however one year after settlement, the first settlers celebrated the anniversary of their arrival and a tradition was born. Over the years, Taihape grew steadily and a major influence on the town was the Main Trunk Line. The government had long planned for it to come through Taihape. As the rail line advanced northward from Wellington, many of the towns ahead of it boomed and died as fortunes fluctuated over the years. Yet Taihape survived to become the town we all enjoy today.

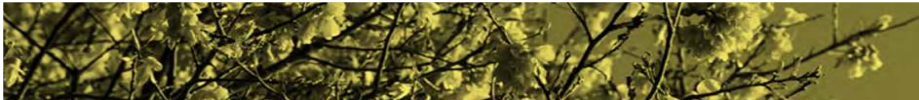

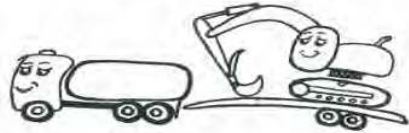

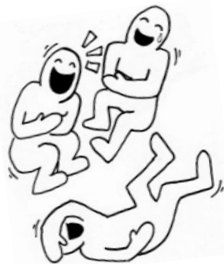
