


FROM THE Mayor'S

We are now in the election period and the critical message here is that people must vote. It is quite concerning that turnout in recent elections has been very low across the district. Voting papers will start being delivered on 16 September please have your say.

At the last Council meeting Taihape did incredibly well in terms of its share of the Better Off funding application to Government for Tranche 1, where \$3.3m is available for the Rangitikei district. Council's thinking is certainly to apply for the maximum amount we are eligible for and part of the thinking behind that was the second tranche of funding may not be available if there's a change of Government. Key projects are bringing forward the investigation and design of the new Taihape Civic Centre and \$375,000 for the Friends of Taihape for the Hautapu Bridges Project, along with looking at funding for housing options.

The Taihape Lobby reopened on 26 August and I would like to thank Kelly Widdowson and Kayla Hyland for the incredible amount of refurbishment that has been done. A huge number of rangatahi youth were there on the day enjoying the new facilities.

I recently had the pleasure of attending the Hautapu River Parks Planting Day where the Taihape community attended in force with about 80 people planting about 1400 trees in around four hours - a great effort! If



I am also thrilled to announce a couple of recent successes for Taihape, Tyson Burrows and Darryl O'Hara have been instrumental in securing funding for an interactive squash court to be installed at the Taihape Squash Club. This is one of only three in New Zealand and will provide squash and racquet-ball training for A-Graders as well as a virtual arcade for interactive junior level fun. Tyson has also been working with Tesla who are conducting a feasibility study around the possibility of installing six super-charge EV units at the Rustic Steakhouse. Both these projects are incredibly exciting for Taihape and my congratulations go to both Tyson and Darryl for their initiative here.

New defibrillators installed across Rangitikei

We've installed four new automated external defibrillators (AEDs) across our District, An AED can increase someone's chance of survival by up to 80% if applied immediately. We want to make accessing AED's easier for our communities. The new locations include:

- Te Matapihi Bulls Community Centre
- Taihape Library
- Council Depot, King Street, Marton
- Council Offices, High Street, Marton

Rangitikei District Council Health Safety and Wellbeing Advisor Marcelle said, "AED's can be the difference between life and death so it was really important for us to make these more accessible for our communities."

Gardening in Taihape

September can be a rather busy time in the garden, this is where our winter work starts to pay off in terms of changes we have implemented throughout the winter. Throughout spring we should be seeing new buds on shrubs and trees that we have planted as structural elements, and groundcovers will be coming forth to cover the ground and shield the soil from weeds. Be wary however of those cold snaps, it is important to remember that we can still get good cold mornings and frost. Holding off on planting tender species for a few weeks could be a good idea.

Fertilising and spraying will be a must to prevent our fruits and vegetables from curly leaf and pest, and also spraying our shrubs and roses from the onset of fungal diseases is a good idea especially if they have had a winter pruning.

In the flower garden, removing spent winter flowering annuals and replacing them with summer additions will ensure that throughout the holidays you'll have a display of flowers and foliage.

Our lawns too will be coming to life and also in need of some attention. Spraying for brand leaf weeds and clover will get them under control before they progress too far. Weed and Feed pre-mixed is a good start for the novice lawn master as this contains the right ratio of fertiliser and weed killer, it's as simple as connecting a hose and applying it to your lawn. Of course, if your slightly more advanced than stronger sprays are available. This should have the pitch game ready for summer in no time.


