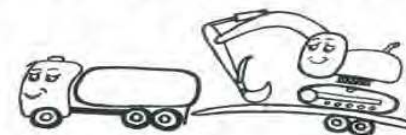

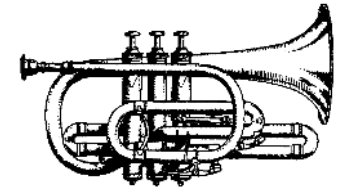

A New Broom for Your Spring Clean

Exposure to Toxins is Inevitable

It is an unfortunate fact of modern life that we are constantly exposed to all manner of toxins; in our homes, cars and workplaces, in the air we breathe, the food we eat and the water we drink. The Many Benefits of Sulforaphane

Sulforaphane not only stimulates detoxification - the process of removing toxins from the body; it is a potent antioxidant as well. This means it helps to clean up your system and repair cellular damage at the same time. These actions are immensely useful, and sulforaphane from broccoli has been shown to improve a wide range of health conditions including autism, heart disease, type two diabetes, asthma, allergies, prostate problems and many more.

Broccoli Seeds and Sprouts Make a Great Combo!

This is a great example of Mother Nature's wisdom, with different parts of the broccoli plant working together to deliver higher amounts of sulforaphane, for greater therapeutic benefits.

Here's to a Healthier You

The following tips can help support your body's natural detoxification processes and reduce oxidation:

- Ensure your diet contains a wide selection of coloured fruits and veges; these are rich in antioxidant phytochemicals for optimal health.
- Drink 2 Litres of filtered water each day to support toxin clearance.
- Get plenty of exercise. As well as improving cellular health and circulation, exercise encourages sweating which is a great way to detox.
